

## ChloroSan

Cleaning and Disinfection or Disinfection Only



- 1. Disposable gloves and apron are required at all times. If there is a risk of splashing, please use safety glasses. Dispose of PPE into correct waste stream and wash hands.
- 2. Use a paper towel to remove any gross contamination before applying ChloroSan.
- Fill the dilution bottle with cold water. Add ChloroSan tablets. The lid must be off until the tablets have dissolved. Dilute as per instructions overleaf.
- Chlorosan solution should be kept for no more than 24 hrs and any residual solution disposed of in suitable drains.
