


## ChloroSan

## Cleaning and Disinfection How to clean **Blood Spills**



Disposable gloves and apron are required at all times. If there is a risk of splashing, please use safety glasses.



Fill the dilution bottle with 500ml of **cold** water. Add 5 ChloroSan tablets (10,000ppm solution). The lid must be off until the tablets have completely dissolved and must then be replaced.



Ensure the spill area is secure. Before applying ChloroSan, place paper towels over the blood spill.



Pour sufficient ChloroSan 10,000ppm solution on to the spill to cover it, and leave for 3 minutes before disposing of the paper towels as clinical waste.



Clean spill area and immediate surroundings with a 10,000ppm ChloroSan solution (5 tablets per 500ml of water).



ChloroSan solution should be kept for max. 24 hours and any residual solution disposed of with cold running water. Rinse bottle. Dispose of PPE into correct waste stream and wash hands.

Always dispose of residual solution after 24 hours, refer to your hospital policy and SDS.
